Smile - Leicestershire Oral Health Promotion Update

Lots of people are aware of the importance of brushing teeth twice a day and avoiding sugary food and drinks. But people may be less aware of the damage that prolonged baby bottle feeding can do, or that a child's first visit to the dentist should be when their first tooth comes through.

The CDS Oral Health Promotion Team recently hosted a number of free bottle swap events at Leicestershire Libraries, encouraging families to introduce drinking from a free-flow cup from 6 months and to stop bottle feeding by 1 year.

Health Visitors from across the County have also been putting some of our popular oral health promotion resources to good use and organised sessions with parents and carers to reinforce the message that prolonged bottle feeding can cause tooth decay.

New resources available now, including role play, books, DVD's and teaching models! The CDS Supervised Tooth Brushing Programme has been commissioned by Leicestershire County Council and is designed to improve the oral health of children in Leicestershire.

Following the success of the pilot scheme earlier in the year, CDS is already working with over forty Early Years Settings to offer three and four year olds the opportunity to brush their teeth with family fluoride toothpaste every day at their Nursery or Pre-School. (This activity does not replace the child's tooth brushing routine at home).

Designated staff receive training and free resources, including toothbrushes and toothpaste, to implement the programme. Please contact the OHP Team for further information and to enrol your setting.
