Our team of qualified, motivated and committed staff provide challenging, age appropriate experiences both indoors and outdoors whilst responding to the individual choices and interests of all children.




Learning Journeys

This Learning Journey will eventually present a fond representation of your child's time with us, their choices, your views and significant achievements and experiences at nursery. We strongly urge you to access this account in order to support your child and their progress.

Pedagogy in Practice...

Our Sessions

We open from 7.45am to 5.45pm, Monday to Friday only closing for one week at Christmas and statutory bank holidays. Fees are not charged during these closures. *See our website for our fee structure.*

Full time place	from 7.45am to 5.45pm, Monday to Friday	
Single full day	from 7.45am to 5.45pm	
Late Charges	please note this is not a facility	

Fees must be paid monthly in advance by standing order; on the first working day.

A non-refundable registration fee is charged at \$85.00 per child.

We offer a **10% discount** for siblings attending, (please refer to terms and conditions).



Meals

We offer a healthy three week menu that has been considered alongside the choices of our families here at Daisy Chain. Our menus are reviewed bi-yearly and your suggestions are always welcome. All meals are prepared daily by our nursery cook.

We provide breakfast, a two course lunch, a mid afternoon tea and a snack during the course of the day.



Drinks are provided throughout the day; (Milk or water).

What do I need to bring to nursery?



If your child is under one then you will need to provide for their milk feeds.



Nappies and wipes, (if required).



A change of clothes, (these can be left at nursery on your child's peg).



Any medications / applications required.



Sun hat / sun-cream / wellington boots / raincoat / hat, gloves and scarf, (according to climate).

Nursery Education Funding

Your child may be entitled to a Nursery Education Place for 15 or 30 hours weekly for 38 weeks per year. It is possible to access these hours across a 52-week period by reducing the weekly hours attended; termed 'The Stretched Offer'.
